Health Systems Strengthening

Project HOPE strives to make quality health care available to all, especially in low income countries, where there is less than one hospital per 100,000 people. With support from strong partnerships in the public and private sector, including Ministries of Health, HOPE provides training, technical assistance and expert mentoring in order to build capacity and skill at all levels of a country's health care system.

Humanitarian Assistance & Disaster Relief

Project HOPE has a long history of providing humanitarian assistance and disaster relief to countries in need. HOPE's two-phased approach begins by responding to disasters and crises with needed emergency medical support including delivery of supplies, medicines and volunteer medical aid. Following the aftermath, HOPE's relief efforts transition into longer term health programs that address gaps in depleted and damaged medical systems and provide sustainable solutions for the affected communities.

Infectious Diseases

Despite much progress, infectious diseases such as Tuberculosis (TB) and HIV still threaten the lives and well-being of millions of people around the world. For 25 years, Project HOPE has implemented infectious disease programs that support the prevention, management and control of these diseases, with our approach specifically targeting the needs of the countries and communities in which we work.

Noncommunicable Diseases

Project HOPE has long been a leader in addressing the global upsurge of noncommunicable diseases – which kill more than 36 million people each year. Our diabetes, cardiovascular disease and cancer programs concentrate on increasing the capacity of health workers to diagnose and treat patients. We also educate and mobilize communities with lifesaving information to promote healthy lifestyle practices and improve the overall health and well-being of individuals and families around the world.

Women's & Children's Health

The health of women and children lies at the core of Project HOPE's programs. Each year, nearly 7 million children under five years of age die from diseases, while more than half a million women die in childbirth – yet most of these deaths are preventable. Through our maternal and child health programs, Project HOPE works to save lives and improve the health and well-being of women, children and their families around the world.

Health Affairs, the nations leading health policy journal, was founded by Project HOPE in 1981. The peer-reviewed journal is a trusted forum for nonpartisan health policy discussion and research and serves as an important source of information by government policymakers and health industry decision makers from the U.S. and around the globe.
